This program offers **short-term, personalized support and guidance for parents and caregivers**. Services can be provided at home, in the community, at school, or online. The goal is to help families feel more **confident and prepared to handle behavior challenges** that may come up when caring for a child or young adult with a developmental disability.

The program is here to **empower families** with practical skills, helpful tools, and advocacy support—**making it easier to navigate everyday life** and reducing the need for more intensive behavior services down the road.

Please note: This is not a comprehensive behavior intervention program.
